NEW STATE LEVELS TESTING RULE

No written tests will be given at camp.

Written tests must be taken at your County Extension office. Once verified that you have passed, you may then schedule a Level II, III or IV riding test by contacting:

CAMP INSTRUCTION TO INCLUDE:

- Ranch Trail Obstacles: Hobbles, ground tie, dragging a log, gates and horsemanship patterns.
- Ranch Roping: A variety of throws, correct and safe dally skills, roping live cattle and dummies.
- Cattle work: cattle sorting, herd holding, individual cow work and ranch cutting.

BUCK BRANNAMAN June 15 and 16

Buck will spend two days with those attending the three day camp that:

- Already hold their Working Ranch Horse rating of level III or IV, or who will be testing for Level III during camp.
- Advanced instruction in roping, individual cow work, ranch cutting plus instruction in laying down the cow and ground crew skills as well as refined horsemanship skills.
- Riders will then join the rest of the campers on day three.

****TWO DAY CAMP: June 13 & 14**

Fundamental skills:

Designed for riders who now hold a Western rating Level I or higher but do not hold a Working Ranch Horse Rating Level II or above. Introduction to Cattle work, herd holding and ranch roping will be the focus of the two day camp. Basic loop building, swinging, delivery and re-coiling will be covered as well as dragging logs. No roping of live cattle during the two day camp is anticipated.

Preparation to pass the Level II Working Ranch Horse riding test is the goal.

Space is limited to 20 participants.

****THREE DAY CAMP: June 15, 16 & 17**

Advanced skills:


Participants in the three day camp must have either:

1. Attended a previous camp or
2. Already hold a Working Ranch Horse rating of Level II or higher.

Preparation for Levels III or IV is the goal.

This group will be roping live cattle.
