Come for a fun day of 4-H Obedience, Showmanship, and Rally. You must be entered in the 4-H Dog Project to enter. There will be a dog costume contest and door prizes are open to the public.

Obedience and Showmanship Classes are open to all 4-H members enrolled in 4-H Dog Care and Training in the current project year.

4-H Classes

Showmanship Classes

*JR, NOVICE	10 years of age and under with one year or less experience
JR. OPEN	10 years of age and under with more than one year experience
*INTER.NOVICE	11-13 years of age with one year or less experience
INTER.OPEN	11-13 years of age with more than one year experience
*SENIOR NOVICE	14 years of age and older with one year or less experience
SENIOR OPEN	14 years of age and older with more than one year experience

*These classes are for those members who are in their first year in the 4-H dog project and have no prior outside showmanship experience as determined by the county. If prior experience is determined by the county, the exhibitor must move into open class competition in their appropriate age group.

Note: Youth entered in B classes are for experienced handlers with a new dog or who have never received a blue ribbon at a previous County Fair Dog Show in the class entered, the exception being sub-novice B. Youth who have been in 4-H Dog Trials for two years or more are not eligible to compete in the Sub-Novice A class or in Junior, Intermediate or Senior Novice Showmanship.

Obedience Classes

SUB-NOVICE -A	First year handler, first year dog.
SUB-NOVICE -B	Second year project members with the same dog and must be the youth and dog team that showed the previous year in Sub-Novice A (on leash)
SUB-NOVICE -C	Experienced handlers with a first year dog only . This class will be judged at a higher skill level than Sub-Novice A or B.
NOVICE -A	Open to members with <u>no prior experience</u> in Novice dog training.
NOVICE -B	Open to <u>experienced</u> members in their 2 nd year or more of Novice 4-H dog training and who have never received a blue ribbon at a previous State Fair in this class. Handlers entering B Classes will be judged at a higher skill level (handler errors) than handlers entered in Novice A classes.
OPEN AND UTILITY	Open to those members who have completed the above classes.
