## Background/Eligibility/Registration

**Background:** The Colorado State 4-H Senate Officer Team plans and conducts this camp for 4-H members in grades 6th through 9th. This event usually happens in November and is held at the Glenwood Springs Recreation Center.

4-H members must be in grades 6th through 9th.

The purpose of this camp is to provide an opportunity for youth to learn teamwork, leadership, communication, and citizenship skills through a variety of workshops.

Registration is through 4HOnline. Early registration opens late August through September 29 and then opens again October 16 and runs through October 20.

### Chaperoning:

One adult/ten youth must be present from each group represented by participants to provide supervision.

If both male and female campers are in attendance, a female and a male chaperon must accompany the local delegation unless special arrangements have been made in advance with another group.
