Chaperone Requirements

Chaperone must be an authorized 4-H leader, a state 4-H staff person or county Extension agent or associate. Individual must have experience chaperoning youth.

Responsibilities

- Abide by the 4-H Code of Conduct
- Ability to fully participate in the activities of the event
- Willing to listen to youth's ideas and expectations for behavior
- Provide guidance to youth delegates

- Strong interest in youth development
- Serve as a positive role model
- Education and/or training in principles of positive youth development
