Paul Hoshiko Jr. Memorial 4-H Golf Tournament History

The tournament is named in honor of long-time Weld County resident Paul Hoshiko Jr. As a youth, he was an exemplary 4-H member and became an outstanding supporter of 4-H all of his adult life. As an International 4-H Youth Exchange (IFYE) delegate in 1952, Paul recognized the worth of this international exchange program as it helps to foster greater cultural understanding. The 4-H Youth selected each year as IFYE delegates spend six months in an exchange to a foreign country then are obligated upon return to the U. S. to spend three months reporting about their experiences to organizations throughout the state. In 1990, Paul established the Paul Hoshiko Jr. IFYE Endowment to ensure the availability of funding for this valuable program.

Tournament's Impact on Colorado Youth

This annual tournament is the 4-H Foundation's major effort to raise valuable funds for statewide 4-H Youth Development Programs.

A portion of the funds supports the Paul Hoshiko Jr. IFYE Endowment. The remaining funds help support a variety of 4-H programs. More than 100,000 young people in Colorado are directly involved in 4-H Youth Development Programs at the county, state, national, and international levels. Projects teach citizenship, teamwork, goal-setting, time-management, and community service, to prepare hundreds of thousands of Colorado youth for a productive future.
