Continuing a long history of support for 4-H, Howard and Marjory Smith have established a scholarship to help defray the costs of college tuition for an outstanding 4-H high school senior.

The scholarship provides \$1,000 per year.

Eligibility:

All Colorado 4-H'ers in their senior year of high school may apply for the Howard E. and Marjory M. Smith 4-H scholarship, and must show:

1. A good academic record - B average or higher, to be maintained in college
2. A real financial need, as determined by the selection committee
3. Submit a 250 word essay explaining how you feel 4-H contributes to basic traditional family values

Application Requirements:

2. High school transcript
3. 250 word essay
4. 1-3 page resume

Selection Process:

Following each scholarship's criteria, recipients will be chosen by the selection committee, comprised of a 4-H Scholar, a 4-H Extension Specialist/4-H Youth Development, and a donor representative from one of the scholarships or a 4-H Foundation member.

Disbursement of Funds:

The recipient will be notified by April 30th and at the State 4-H Conference in June. Scholarship is awarded in spring semester if recipient maintains 3.0 or higher GPA.
