Exhibit: Unit 1 ---Completed e-Record. Article or garment illustrating the skills learned in Unit 1. Exhibits must use a firmly-woven, medium-weight cotton or at least 50% cotton-blend fabric. The exhibit should not include sewing techniques used in higher units. Unit 2---Completed e-Record. Garment or outfit illustrating use of commercial pattern with one or more of these techniques: facing (no buttonholes or button loops, darts, no-ease sleeve, fasteners, or bias application in firmly woven, medium-weight cotton or at least 50% cotton-blend fabric. Unit 3---Completed e-Record. Garment of outfit illustrating one or more of the following techniques: set-in sleeves without cuffs, waist treatments and zippers in a cotton or cotton-blend woven or knit fabric. Unit 4 ---Completed e-Record. Garment or outfit illustrating two or more of the following techniques: cuffs, or plackets, collars, and buttons with buttonholes in a cotton or at least 50% cotton-blend woven or knit fabric. Other techniques may be used in addition to the two required techniques. Judges may use back of form for more comments.
