

OUTSTANDING 4-H ALUMNI AWARD CRITERIA

The Outstanding 4-H Alumni Award is to recognize continued support to the 4-H Youth Development Program by individuals who were 4-H members, either in Colorado or another state.

The Outstanding 4-H Alumni Award winners will be selected based upon the following criteria:

- Support to the 4-H program in their county, region and/or state level.
- Contributions to their community via clubs, boards, committees, etc.
- Involvement in regional and/or statewide efforts.

Individuals may be nominated by:

- Any Extension staff member or affiliated 4-H board or committee.
- Via submission of a nomination form (two pages maximum).
- Due in the State 4-H office by June 1 each year.
- Letter of recommendation by nominator.

Selection: Will be done via a committee representing the Colorado 4-H Youth Fund, Inc., State 4-H office and Cooperative Extension.

Recognition: All nominees will be presented with a certificate thanking them for their support of the 4-H program during the Leadership Development Conference or another appropriate statewide 4-H event. Two individuals will be selected to receive special recognition from those nominated.

Sponsors: The Outstanding 4-H Alumni Awards are sponsored by the Colorado 4-H Youth Fund, Inc., and the Colorado 4-H Youth Development Program.

National Competition: Colorado 4-H Alumni Award recipients will be submitted for competition for the National 4-H Alumni Awards.
