What:	Travel to Japan with 4-H youth from across the U.S. (Adult chaperones on international flights and in Japan). Live with a Japanese host family during your stay.	What:	For the first 4 weeks, stay with a host family in the Tokyo area, learn Japanese language in a classroom setting, and explore Japanese culture outside the classroom. After 4 weeks, you will move to a second host family in the Tokyo area or in another area of Japan.
When:	July 8 to August 6, 2009	When:	June 11 to August 6, 2009
How:	This exchange is coordinated with 3 different Japanese organizations: Labo Foundation, LEX Institute, and Utrek International Exchange Center. Labo and Utrek programs offer a group camp. No group camp for LEX. Please see your 4-H Coordinator for more details on each organization's program.	How:	The first 4 weeks of the exchange is coordinated by the Labo Foundation. For the second 4 weeks, you may homestay with either Labo, LEX or Utrek. Labo and Utrek programs offer a group camp. No group camp for LEX.
