Project Tips:

- Creative clothing projects are evaluated on creativity, quality of workmanship and design.
- Pattern ***"Instruction Sheet"*** is required for Unit 5 and must be attached securely in the binder with the e-record and supplement.
- Note that Create Your Own is for Intermediates (11-13) and Senior(14-18) members.
- An exhibit shall consist of no more that three coordinated pieces. (No accessory items, i.e. shoes, jewelry, hats, scarves, etc.) All clothing pieces must be securely attached together on hangers.
- For first year members it may be easier to do the stitching process than the painting or gluing process.
- All garment pieces need to be labeled. Use either a piece of muslin and fabric pen or fabric label and include your name, age, clothing unit and county.
- Have fun with the 4-H story section of e-record. Follow directions and tell what you learned.
- Enter your exhibit in the county fair
- Share the information learned in talks and displays

Judging Criteria:

- Completeness of e-record.
- Extra activities such as demonstrations, talks, story, and pictures added to your e-record. Several photos with at least one action shot of the member doing something with their project.
- Neatness and legibility
