Project Tips:

- Use the manual only as a resource not as a record.
- Provide pictures of other items made during your project on your photo page--- Unit 1 & 2
- Provide two or more photos of exhibit showing item in place where it will be used and showing item as a part of the total room scheme (plan). (Exception: The room design—Unit 3)
- Provide photos of other items made, refurbished or purchased during your project on your photo page---Unit 4, 5, & 6
- Provide up to three photos showing exhibit item(s) in use---Unit 4 & 6 ---up to five photos for Unit 5.
- On a separate paper write a description of the plan in the room and how your accessory fits (window treatment or bed cover—Unit 5) (refinished or refurbished piece—Unit 6) into the plan---Unit 4
- Provide pictures showing the original piece, one during the progression of the refurbishing or refurbishing process and one of the complete piece (one pate, one side only) ---Unit 6.
- Have fun with the 4-H story section of e-record. Follow directions and tell what you learned.
- Enter your exhibit in the county fair
- Share the information learned in talks and displays

Judging Criteria:

- Completeness of e-record.
- Extra activities such as demonstrations, talks, story, and pictures added to your e-record. Several photos with at least one action shot of the member doing something with their project.
- Neatness and legibility
- Would be nice if your community service project related to your project.
- Quality of exhibit
