Project Tips:

- Exhibits must be entered in discipline that the exhibit relates to:
 - Archery
 - Air Rifle
 - Shotgun
 - .22 Rifle
 - Air Pistol
 - Muzzleloading
 - Outdoor Skills
 - Miscellaneous
- The exhibit can be display board or stand-alone items such as gun stocks, decoys, etc. but not both.
- The area you select is the exhibit class that you will choose.
- Any safety idea always makes a good display
- Proper shooting techniques work well
- Remember, do not use live ammo or a functional gun in your display. This is a safety issue.
- Complete your shooting sports inventory and individual score record and your e-record and secure these two items in a sturdy binder/notebook.

Tips for an overall outstanding exhibit:

- 1) Follows unit requirements and rules in the fairbook
- 2) Attractive
- 3) Relatively simple
- 4) Colorful and /or showing strong contrast
- 5) Creative or artistic
- 6) Sturdy (won't fall apart in transit)
- 7) Educational
- 8) Intriguing
- 9) Gives viewer the impression that you enjoyed this project
- 10) Makes the viewer remark "wow" or "nicely done".

Judging Criteria For E-Record:

- Completeness e-record
- Completeness of shooting sports inventory record
- Completeness of shooting sports individual discipline records
- Extra activities such as demonstrations, talks, and community service recorded in your e-record.
- Would be nice if community service was related to your project
- Neatness and legibility
- Quality of exhibit
