The Intermediate Child Development Unit 3 is for members ages 11-13 years old. This project will help youth understand how children grow and appropriate activities for children of different ages. Members will accomplish the following learning experiences:

Unit 3

- Members will complete seven activities at the end of each chapter studied.
- Members will complete two More to Grow On activities for each chapter studied. One of these activities will be your exhibit and you will report on it in Questions 1- 6 at the end of the chapter studied.
- Explore development stages, arts and crafts, games, music, stories and poems, toys and play.
- Share talents acquired through demonstrations and exhibits.

The Senior Child Development Unit 4 is for members ages 14-18 years old. This project will help youth learn more advanced skills about child development and understanding of children from the infant age/stage through the early school-age/stage of 6 to 8. Members will also learn about careers working with children. Members will accomplish the following learning experiences:

Unit 4

- Members will complete seven activities at the end of each chapter studied.
- Members will complete two More to Grow On activities for each chapter studied. One of these activities will be your exhibit and you will report on it in Questions 1- 6 at the end of the chapter studied.
- Develop skills in the guidance and discipline of young children.
- Learn about appropriate activities related to nutrition, safety, and parties.
- Explore a variety of careers that use child development knowledge and skills.
- Share talents acquired through demonstrations and exhibits.
