### Project Tips:

- 4-H members can exhibit both as an individual and/or as part of a group. The exhibits need to be different -- one exhibit for the individual and a different topic exhibit for the group.
- In Setting Out, the member can choose to either do an exhibit from "Take Me on a Tour" or "What are Geographical Tools".
- Individual exhibits must have an e-record.
- Group projects need to be developed by two or more 4-H members with a one page story about the project, including items such as purpose of map, goals, plan, accomplishments, evaluation and how each person on the team contributed to the project.
- Enter your project in the county fair.
- Share information learned in talks and displays.

### Judging Criteria:

- Completeness of e-record
- E-record includes demonstrations, talks, story, and pictures, with at least one action shot of the member doing something with his or her project
- Neatness and legibility
- Quality of exhibit
