Hello Colorado 4-H Volunteers,

Have you ever wondered how you as a 4-H volunteer can have your voice heard at the state level?

Have you ever thought of a suggestion or idea and didn't know how to share your idea?

Did you know that there is a Colorado 4-H Volunteer work group that was created to help give our Colorado 4-H volunteers a voice!

What is the State 4-H Cloverleaf Work Group?

The 4-H Cloverleaf Work Group is made up of two 4-H volunteers from each of the three regions in Colorado who exemplify the acronym LEAF (Leadership, Energy, Attitude, Future of 4-H). Representatives from this group will participate in the 4-H Roundtable, which is a bi-monthly Zoom video conference with State 4-H Staff, 4-H Work Team Leaders, and other Extension Agents from around Colorado. Roundtable members help set and revise the State 4-H policies that guide the Colorado 4-H program, and provide input regarding use of state 4-H fees and on emerging issues that are managed by the State 4-H Office. Members of the 4-H Cloverleaf Work Group will also work in consultation with the Volunteer Work Team, meet quarterly via a Zoom meeting and serve either a one or two-year term.

What type of 4-H volunteers are we looking for to serve as members of this group?

The Leadership and Volunteer Development Work Team invites 4-H agents to nominate transformational leaders to apply for the 4-H Cloverleaf Work Group. We are looking for volunteers who want to be leaders/mentors for future generations. They like working with young people and other volunteers. They believe in the importance of teaching life skills. They like having an impactful commitment. They want to build relationships with kids, as well as other volunteers, and they like to set a positive example.

What is the selection process?

We currently have open positions in the Front Range (1) and the Peaks & Plains Region (1). Please contact your local 4-H agent if you are interested in being nominated for the Volunteer Cloverleaf Work Group.

County 4-H agents may nominate approved, enrolled, 4-H volunteers by submitting this Cloverleaf Work Group Nominee Application (completed by the volunteer nominee) along with a letter of recommendation from the county agent, to the State 4-H Office by May 1, 2018.
