The Top 6 Youth in both Junior Division (age 9-13) and Senior Division (age 14+) will be invited to a televised shoot-off on Sunday August 20 at the BUCKMASTERS TOP BOW INDOOR RANGE!

The 2017 Tournament will be conducted in a wooded setting, with stations along a trail in a format similar to an ASA tournament. There will be 3 start times on **Saturday August 19** with a "shotgun start": 10 AM-12 noon; 12:30-2:30 PM; and 3-5 PM. Youth will begin at an assigned station and move through the course in squads of 5, and shooters will be squadded together by County or State delegations, as much as feasible. Please indicate your preference for start time during the online registration process. After you receive confirmation of your registration via 4-HONLINE, email your squadding preference to andresh@auburn.edu and sfb0010@auburn.edu with "Squadding" in the Subject line. Membership in Alabama 4-H not required, however all registration must be submitted via 4-H Online. Tournament Rules and Regulations

Membership in Alabama 4-H not required.

- 1. Go to www.alabama4h.com to register. Easy instructions for Out-of-State and non-4-H Competitors are provided!
- 2. Competitor Relay Times and Squads will be posted at On-Site Registration the day of the match. Be available 45 minutes prior to assigned time for equipment check in.
- 3. Each participant is required to use his or her own equipment including side quiver (*Easton or Beman Arrows are encouraged, but not required*). In case of equipment failure, a participant may borrow the parts necessary to fix his or her equipment as long as the actual recurve/compound bow is the participant's primary or back-up bow.
- 4. 4-H reserves the right to prohibit any individual from using any technique that we deem to be dangerous to a participant or spectators.
- 5. Participants must be age 9 and no older than 19 by January 1, 2017. Registrants must be supervised and coached at all times on the range by an adult archery Coach in good standing, representing the youth's

- organization of affiliation (4-H, NASP, BHA, ASA, JOAD, Scholastic 3-D). Verification of Coach Credentials may be requested at On-Site Registration. Youth will be supervised by their Coach at all times on the range.
- 6. In the event that an equipment failure occurs, five minutes will be allowed to repair or replace their equipment. A longer period may be granted if deemed appropriate by the Range Master. The shooter will forfeit the target that was missed when the equipment failed.

7. FORMAT:

- a. Junior 3-D Course: 30 targets min., 40 targets max.
 - 1. Targets are 3-D competition size.
 - 2. Some targets MAY be required to be shot from a platform at about three feet above the ground.
 - 3. Participants should expect a <u>minimum</u> of **30 shots (1 per target)** ranging from **5 to 30 yards**. The number of shots will depend on the number of participants, not to exceed 40 shots for the match.
 - 4. Competitors should be able to **nock** and **shoot** ten arrows at a 10-target sequence in approximately **4 min.**
 - 5. Scoring
 - a. ASA Scoring procedures, dependent upon type of 3-D targets available
 - i. +12 pts. (lower 12 only)
 - ii. +10 pts. (10 ring)
 - iii. +8 pts. (8 ring)
 - iv. +5 pts. (Any other body shot)
 - v. 0 [Misses, glancing shots, not touching body color (horns, rocks, logs, etc...) Hooves are considered body color.]
 - b. Ties will be broken by the number of highest number of 12s, then number of 10s, 8s, etc.
- b. Senior 3-D Course: 30 targets min., 40 targets max.
 - 1. Targets are 3-D competition size.
 - 2. Some targets MAY be required to be shot from a platform at about three feet above the ground.
 - 3. Participants should expect a minimum of **20 shots** (**1 per target**) ranging from **1 to 50** yards. Competitors should be able to **nock** and **shoot** ten arrows at a **10**-target sequence in approximately **2 min. 40 sec.**
 - 4. Scoring
 - a. ASA Scoring procedures, dependent upon type of 3-D targets available
 - i. +12 pts. (lower 12 only)
 - ii. +10 pts. (10 ring)
 - iii. +8 pts. (8 ring)
 - iv. +5 pts. (Any other body shot)
 - v. 0 [Misses, glancing shots, not touching body color (horns, rocks, logs, etc...) Hooves are considered body color.]
 - b. Ties will be broken by the number of highest number of 12s, then number of 10s, 8s, etc.
- 8. **Prizes and Awards:** The Top 10 individuals in the Junior and Senior divisions will be recognized after each event as well as Overall. Six Junior Division and Six Senior Division "Youth Top Bow Indoor World Championship" competitors will be recognized. Further recognition in the form of prizes and awards will be based upon the number of participants.

9. **Equipment:**

- a. Compound, Recurve, Genesis, and Long Bows are allowed
 - i. <u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: There will not be separate categories for each bow type. Each participant will be competing against everyone.
- b. Maximum stabilizer length of 12 inches. Limit 1 stabilizer on the bow.
- c. Any type of lighting device is allowed on sights (lighted sight pins, auxiliary sight lighting device, etc.).
- d. No magnification (scope) sights or laser sights.
- e. <u>A sight with fixed pins or crosshairs or beaded wire is legal</u>. Levels are legal (# of pins, crosshairs or beads optional). Rail sights are legal.
- f. Adjustments in equipment may be made in between rounds
- g. Each contestant will need a minimum of 18 arrows per event.
- h. Arrows must have screw in or glue in field tips.
- i. No broadheads or blunts.
- j. An arrow speed of **300 FPS** will be allowed. A 3% + will be allowed for variations in chronographs.
 - i. PLEASE NOTE: Each participant could have their bow tested at ANY TIME.
 - ii. Those participants shooting above **300 FPS** prior to competition MAY be required to shoot through the chronograph again and is at the legal limit. Once competition has commenced any competitor who shoots above 309 FPS when tested, will forfeit any previous shots in that round. A score of "0" will be given for that round(s). The competitor may make the necessary changes to their bow and shoot any future rounds of competition. 4-H reserves the right to test any competitors bow speed through our chronograph at any time during the Archery Tournament. Any competitor refusing to have their equipment tested when instructed to do so will be disqualified from the tournament.
- 10. The presence or use of range finders by participants/parents/spectators at any event will result in immediate **disqualification** for any individual involved. <u>NO binoculars</u> will be allowed on the 3-D course.
- 11. Participants are NOT ALLOWED to have a cell phone on any range or while waiting during the 3-D event. Any youth seen with one will be disqualified. Parents are allowed to have cellular devices, but must keep them on silent or vibrate. Only in emergency situations may they be used in the immediate vicinity of the competitive ranges during active competition.
- 12. **NO practice** is allowed unless a Warm-up Area is designated by Match Officials. Where practice is not permitted on competition ranges, no shooter, coach or other individual aside from authorized range staff shall preview, walk, scout, use range finding devices, or attempt to inform competitors of shooting distances, shot placement, or other information designed to give the shooter an advantage.
- 13. Once record shooting begins, absolutely no coaching is permitted. All youth and adults should set an example of integrity and honesty.
- 14. If an arrow bounces out of a target, the resulting score will be zero. The youth will not be allowed to re-shoot the arrow.
- 15. DRESS CODE: Please adhere to the Alabama 4-H Code of Conduct and Dress Code http://www.aces.edu/4-H-youth/AL4-H/resources/documents/Dress_Code_Philosophy.pdf. Any youth participating in inappropriate attire will be asked to leave the range and change clothes. They will not be allowed to participate until they are in compliance with the 4-H Dress Code. Closed toe shoes are required for this tournament; due to wooded setting, consider liberal application of insect repellant.
- 16. Other than bottled water, concessions may not be available at the venue; please plan accordingly.

AIR RIFLE CMP CUP MATCH

Match Rules & Information

LOCATION: Montgomery, Alabama - Montgomery Multiplex Arena

DATE: Saturday, August 19, 2017

HOST: Alabama 4-H SAFE - Montgomery County 4-H River Region Rifles Shooting Sports Club

EVENTS: This is a sanctioned air rifle CMP Cup Match as part of the Buckmasters Expo http://www.buckmasters.com/Resources/Expo . The course of fire is a 3x20 using electronic targets. Time allowed for each position will be in accordance with the rules cited below.

ELIGIBILITY: The **Youth Air Rifle Cup Match** is open to competitors who have not graduated from high school (Junior and Senior age divisions). Membership in the 4-H is not required. The minimum age is 9 years old on the day of the competition.

Teams will consist of four shooters from the same school or club. No "all star" teams. The age group the team is determined by the oldest competitor on the team. Individuals may not participate on more than one team and may compete in one category only. The team score is determined by the sum of the top three individual scores on that team.

Teams must be declared prior to any member of that team shooting. Schools or clubs may have more than one team in each age group.

The **Air Rifle Open Class Match** is open to competitors who are 18 years old (graduated from high school or equivalent, thus ineligible for the cup match) and older. (As detailed in Section 3 of the CMP 3-P AR rules, cited below). There is no team competition in the Air Rifle Open Class Match.

<u>All Air Rifle competitors must have a CMP Competitor Number</u>. If you do not already have one, then you can apply for a FREE number at the Civilian Marksmanship Program website. The website address is: https://ct.thecmp.org/app/v1/index.php?do=register

SCHEDULE: Air rifle relays will be held on Saturday at 9 a.m. and 12 p.m. Please arrive 1 hour prior to the beginning time of the relay.

CLASSES: Sporter Class and Precision Class, per the rules cited below.

AGE GROUPS: Athletes will be categorized in the following age divisions:

- * Senior (J1 & J2) Competitors who will reach their 15th, 16th, 17th or 18th birthday in 2017. Those 18 years of age must not have graduated high school or equivalent.
- * Junior (J3) Competitors who are 9 years of age or older on the day of the competition, but will also not reach their 15th birthday in 2017.
- * Open (O) Non-school age competitors who are 18 years of age (graduated from high school or equivalent) or older.

RULES: 2016-2018 National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules, 11th Edition. This is a CMP Cup Match. EIC points are governed and awarded by current CMP EIC rules.

SPECIAL EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS: Anyone forward of the ready line, must wear approved eye protection or prescription glasses. This includes Open Age Group competitors. Closed toe shoes are required for all competitors.

AWARDS: Awards will be presented for the following after the last relay on Saturday:

- 1. Medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd, place individuals in each age group (Junior, Senior, and Open) for both Sporter and Precision class.
- 2. Team trophy or plaque will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams in each age group (Junior and Senior) for both Sporter and Precision class. Team members who place will also receive a medal.

ELIGIBILITY: The Progressive Position Air Pistol Match is open to competitors who are at least 9 years of age on the day of the competition and over of the year of the competition. Membership in the 4-H is not required.

CLASSES: There are five classes based on age and the shooting position. The definition of each of these shooting positions is covered in the rules. These classes are:

Basic Supported: The minimum age is 9 years on the day of the competition. The maximum age is 12 (Athletes must be under 13 years old on December 31 of the year of the competition).

Standing Supported: The minimum age is 9 years on the day of the competition. The maximum age is 14 (Athletes must be under 15 years old on December 31 of the year of the competition).

Sub-junior International Standing: The minimum age is 9 years on the day of the competition. The maximum age is 14 (Athletes must be under 15 years old on December 31 of the year of the competition).

Junior International Standing: The minimum age is 15 and the maximum age is 20 (Athletes must be under the age of 21 and over the age of 15 on December 31 of the year of the competition).

Adult International Standing: The minimum age is 21 (Athletes must be under the age of 22 on December 31 of the year of the competition).

<u>All competitors must have a CMP Competitor Number</u>. If you do not already have one, then you can apply for a FREE number at the Civilian Marksmanship Program website free of charge. The website address is: https://ct.thecmp.org/app/v1/index.php?do=register

SCHEDULE: One Air Pistol relay will be held on Saturday at 2 p.m. Please arrive 1 hour prior to the beginning time of the relay.

LOCATION: Montgomery, Alabama **DATE:** Saturday, August 19, 2017

HOST: Shelby County Shooting Sports Association – Birmingham, AL

EVENTS: This is a 4-Position 5-meter BB gun competition. Course of fire is 10 shots in each of four positions with unlimited sighters. Time allowed for each position will be 10 minutes. Order of firing will be prone, standing, sitting and kneeling. There will be a 3-minute preparation period before each stage of the competition.

ELIGIBILITY: The BB match is open to competitors who have not reached their 16th birthday by the date of the match. The minimum age allowed is 9 years. 4-H membership is not required.

Teams will consist of five shooters from the same school or club. No "All Star" teams. Individuals may not participate on more than one team. The age class of the team is determined by the oldest competitor on the team. The team score is determined by the sum of the top four individual scores on that team.

Teams must be declared prior to any member of that team shooting. Schools or clubs may have more than one team in each age group.

SCHEDULE: BB Gun relays will be held on Saturday at 11 a.m. and 1 p.m. Please arrive 1 hour prior to the beginning time of the relay.

AGE GROUPS: The competitor's age group is determined by their age on the date of the match. They are:

- *Senior (BB1) Competitors who are age 13, 14, or 15.
- * Junior (BB2 & BB3) Competitors who are age 9, 10, 11 or 12.

RULES: NRA BB Gun Rules, Effective January 2016.

CHALLENGES: A 15 minute review period will be allowed as soon as possible after the conclusion of each relay. A \$2 challenge fee will be assessed for each lost challenge.

SPECIAL EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS: Competitors must provide their own equipment. Only the Daisy Model 499 Muzzle Loading BB Gun is permitted.

Anyone forward of the ready line, must wear approved eye protection or prescription glasses.

ASSISTANCE: An assistant (coach, parent, or leader) will be allowed to spot and load for the competitor during the course of fire.
